The New South Wales Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) is satisfied that the Strategic Bushfire Assessment report prepared by Eco Logical Australia Pty Ltd (Referenced: 17CAN_7794, dated 14 February 2019) sufficiently addresses the matters identified in Condition 11 of the Altered Gateway Determination dated 28 August 2018 to allow for the Planning Proposal to progress to the public exhibition stage. Notwithstanding, the NSW RFS will provide a more detailed formal response during subsequent agency consultation as part of this exhibition process.
