Planning proposal to amend various Gosford local planning instruments

I am writing in response to your Council's letter dated 16 July 2013 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to rezone land at Central Coast Highway and Bakali Road, Forresters Beach to 2(a) Residential and 7(a) Conservation and Scenic Protection (Conservation) by amending Gosford Interim Development Order 122 and Gosford Planning Scheme Ordinance or rezone the land to R2 Low Density Residential and E2 Environmental Conservation and amend the applicable development standards under draft Gosford Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2009.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

Council may wish to consider whether it still seeks to defer the 31 residential lots fronting the Central Coast Highway, currently zoned 7(c2) Conservation and Scenic Protection (Scenic Protection – Rural Small Holdings) under Gosford Interim Development Order 122, from draft Gosford LEP 2009 or whether it seeks to include these lands straight into the draft LEP and remove them from this planning proposal, given they have already been exhibited under the draft LEP. This will enable the rezoning of this land to progress under the draft Gosford LEP 2009. If Council supports this position, it is to amend the planning proposal accordingly, prior to undertaking public exhibition.

Council still needs to obtain the Director General's agreement to satisfy the requirements of relevant S117 Directions. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has now accepted this delegation. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending LEP is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2013_GOSFO_004_00): to rezone land at Forresters Beach for residential and environmental purposes.

I, the Executive Director, Rural and Regional Planning at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Gosford Interim Development Order 122 and Gosford Planning Scheme Ordinance to rezone land at Central Coast Highway and Bakali Road, Forresters Beach to 2(a) Residential and 7(a) Conservation and Scenic Protection (Conservation) or rezone the land to R2 Low Density Residential and E2 Environmental Conservation and amend the applicable development standards under draft Gosford Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2009 should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to undertaking public exhibition, Council is to update the planning proposal to:
 - provide a plain English explanation of the objectives or intended outcomes of the planning proposal and how the intended outcomes are to be achieved by means of amending the relevant local planning instruments;
 - remove the discussion on the history of former rezoning and development applications, justification for zones, lot sizes and for bringing forward the proposal in advance of draft Gosford LEP 2009 from the 'objectives or intended outcomes' section of the planning proposal and instead include this information in the 'justification' section of the planning proposal; and
 - update the land zoning and other development standards mapping, once information regarding land capability has been obtained.
- 2. Once Council has undertaken consultation with public authorities and obtaining relevant information on land capability, traffic, environment, flooding, water quality and bushfire, it is to update the planning proposal to include sufficient additional information to adequately demonstrate consistency or justify any inconsistency with the below S117 Directions and other relevant documents and policies:
 - 2.1 Environment Protection Zones
 - 2.2 Coastal Protection
 - 4.3 Flood Prone Land
 - 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection
 - 5.1 Implementation of Regional Strategies
 - State Environmental Planning Policy (SEPP) 71 Coastal Protection
 - Central Coast Regional Strategy
- 3. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**;
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013).



- Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the 4. EP&A Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:
 - Hunter Central Rivers Catchment Management Authority
 - NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service
 - Transport for NSW Roads and Maritime Services
 - NSW Rural Fire Service (S117 Direction 4.4. Planning for Bushfire Protection)
 - Office of Environment and Heritage (S117 Direction 2.1 Environment Protection Zones)

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

- A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under 5. section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the week following the 6. date of the Gateway determination.
