### **Planning proposal to amend Newcastle Local Environmental Plan 2012**

I am writing in response to your Council's request for a Gateway determination under section 56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") in respect of the planning proposal to rezone part of the land at 60-80 Sandgate Road, Wallsend to R2 Low Density Residential and allocate a maximum building height of 8.5m, a maximum floor space ratio of 0.6:1 and a minimum lot size of 450sqm for the subject land.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I have also agreed the planning proposal's inconsistency with S117 Direction 4.1 Acid Sulfate Soils is of minor significance. No further approval is required in relation to this Direction.

Council may still need to obtain the Director General's agreement to satisfy the requirements of relevant S117 Directions. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the plan being made.

The Minister delegated his plan making powers to councils in October 2012. It is noted that Council has now accepted this delegation. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan. Council should contact the regional office of the department should it require assistance in relation to the exercise of its delegation, including assistance with access to GIS support.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office 6 weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the department for administrative purposes.

The State Government is committed to reducing the time taken to complete LEPs by tailoring the steps in the process to the complexity of the proposal, and by providing clear and publicly available justification for each plan at an early stage. In order to meet these commitments, the Minister may take action under section 54(2)(d) of the EP&A Act if the time frames outlined in this determination are not met.

## Gateway Determination

**Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP\_2013\_NEWCA\_004\_00):** to rezone land at Sandgate Road, Wallsend and amend the development standards applying to the land.

I, the Executive Director, Rural and Regional Planning at the Department of Planning and Infrastructure as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, have determined under section 56(2) of the EP&A Act that an amendment to the Newcastle Local Environmental Plan (LEP) 2012 to rezone part of the land at 60-80 Sandgate Road, Wallsend to R2 Low Density Residential and allocate a maximum building height of 8.5m, a maximum floor space ratio of 0.6:1 and a minimum lot size of 450sqm for the subject land should proceed subject to the following conditions:

1. Council is to ensure that the planning proposal satisfies the requirements of State Environmental Planning Policy (SEPP) 55 – Remediation of Land. If required, Council is to prepare an initial site contamination investigation report to demonstrate that the site is suitable for rezoning to the proposed zone. This report is to be included as part of the public exhibition material.
2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 ("EP&A Act") as follows:
  - (a) the planning proposal is classified as low impact as described in *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013)* and must be made publicly available for a minimum of **14 days**; and
  - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of *A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning & Infrastructure 2013)*.
3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the EP&A Act and/or to comply with the requirements of or demonstrate consistency with relevant S117 Directions:
  - NSW Rural Fire Service (S117 Direction 4.4 Planning for Bushfire Protection)
  - Hunter - Central Rivers Catchment Management Authority (S117 Directions 2.1 Environment Protection Zones)
  - Office of Environment and Heritage (S117 Directions 2.1 Environment Protection Zones and 4.3 Flood Prone Land).

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).



5. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be **12 months** from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
