Planning proposal to amend Goulburn-Mulwaree Local Environmental Plan 2009

I am writing in response to your Council's letters dated 5 October and 25 July 2016 requesting a Gateway determination under section 56 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979 (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal to remove the West Goulburn Urban Release Area for land north of Ducks Lane including Bonnett Drive, Park Close, and Shannon Drive, West Goulburn from the LEP.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have now determined the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the attached Gateway determination.

I note your 5 October advice that Council staff and the NSW Office of Environment and Heritage have had extensive discussions with landowners in the Shannon Drive portion of the release area about the significant ecological attributes present on the land identified for subdivision. I also understand that OEH has ground-truthed and mapped these attributes and has provided copies of the map to the landowners and their planning consultant.

I consider that there is merit for Council to update the relevant Terrestrial Biodiversity Map in the Goulburn-Mulwaree LEP 2009 to recognise this significant vegetation to ensure that it is considered in any development assessment process.

Plan making powers were delegated to councils by the Minister in October 2012. It is noted that Council has requested to be issued with delegation for this planning proposal. I have considered the nature of Council's planning proposal and have decided to issue an authorisation for Council to exercise delegation to make this plan.

The amending Local Environmental Plan (LEP) is to be finalised within 12 months of the week following the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request to draft and finalise the LEP should be made directly to Parliamentary Counsel's Office six weeks prior to the projected publication date. A copy of the request should be forwarded to the Department of Planning and Environment for administrative purposes.

Council should submit copies of the draft LEP maps and spatial data (as well as a copy of the final Planning Proposal and Council's Section 59 Report) to the Department via the NSW Planning Portal which can be accessed via http://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au. It would be appreciated if Council could also email the Southern Region office to notify that it has uploaded this information to the Portal.

Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP_2016_GOULB_002_00): to delete the Urban Release Area from land north of Ducks Lane including Bonnett Drive, Park Close, and Shannon Drive, West Goulburn.

I, Linda Davis, the Acting Director Regions, Southern, Planning Services at the Department of Planning and Environment as delegate of the Minister for Planning, have determined under section 56(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) that an amendment to the *Goulburn-Mulwaree Local Environmental Plan 2009* as described above should proceed subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Council is to revise the planning proposal to include an updated Terrestrial Biodiversity Map that identifies the areas of native vegetation that have been mapped by the Office of Environment and Heritage, particularly for the Shannon Drive site, prior to community consultation. The revised planning proposal is to include a revised "Part 2 Explanation of provisions" to reflect the inclusion of an updated Terrestrial Biodiversity Map.
- 2. Community consultation is required under sections 56(2)(c) and 57 of the Act as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal must be made publicly available for a minimum of **28 days**; and
 - (b) the relevant planning authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in section 5.5.2 of A Guide to Preparing LEPs (Department of Planning and Environment 2013).
- 3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities under section 56(2)(d) of the Act and/or to comply with the requirements of relevant S117 Directions:
 - The Office of Environment and Heritage
 - WaterNSW (S.117 Direction 5.2 Sydney Drinking Water Catchments)
 - NSW Rural Fire Service (S.117 Direction 4.4)

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material, and given at least 21 days to comment on the proposal.

- 4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 56(2)(e) of the Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
- 5. The LEP maps shall be prepared in accordance with the Standard Technical Requirements for Spatial Datasets and Maps (Department of Planning and Environment, 2015).

6. The timeframe for completing the LEP is to be 12 months from the week following the date of the Gateway determination.
