## **REZONING REVIEW**

PP-2022-1337, 152 Bunnerong Road, Eastgardens

The rezoning review request seeks to amend the Bayside Local Environmental Plan 2021 in relation to land at 152 Bunnerong Road, Eastgardens to increase the maximum building height and FSR and introduce a new local provision.

Reason for Review:

The Council has notified the proponent that the request to prepare a planning proposal has not been supported

The Council has failed to indicate its support 90 days after the proponent submitted a request to prepare a planning proposal or took too long to submit the proposal after indicating its support

## PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the material listed at item 4 and the matters raised and/or observed at meetings and site inspections listed at item 5 in Schedule 1.

Based on this review, the Panel resolved to defer consideration for gateway pending the furnishings of additional information as set out below:

- The Proponent is to provide further justification for strategic merit, In particular, consistency with the Eastern City District Plan and the Local Strategic Planning Statement. Notably, the Applicant is to clearly demonstrate how this planning proposal will aid in the achievement of Planning Priority E11 of the Eastern City District Plan as it applies to the Eastgardens-Maroubra Junction strategic centre as a whole. The Applicant is to have regard to any more recent, relevant and available local planning studies and strategies.
- Details be provided of a public benefit offer made to Council following discussions between the proponent and the Council. The Panel notes that generally, such a public benefit offer would relate to local infrastructure, services or facilities otherwise provided by the Council.
- The Council advise the Panel of the requirements of TfNSW for an upgraded bus interchange.
- The Council's Design Excellence Panel meet and consider the proponents proposal and advise the Panel accordingly, in particular in relation to the height, massing and location of proposed new built form.

The Panel's decision was unanimous.
