

PP-2022-2519 – 4,12, and 14 Cowan Road, St Ives

The Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure issued a Gateway Determination on 12 July 2024. An assessment against the Gateway Determination has been undertaken (see **Table 1**).

The Planning Proposal Authority team is satisfied that the planning proposal and supporting documents have met the conditions of the Gateway Determination and the planning proposal can proceed to finalisation.
