**RECOMMENDATION:** Councillor Mahoney and Councillor Symington

That Council, having regard to its earlier resolutions **MM011-21**, **NM056-21**, **NM060-21** and **ENV048-21** to protect and preserve the property known as 'Glenlee' located at 80 Boronia Parade, Lugarno:

- (a) Acknowledges the importance of 'Glenlee', 80 Boronia Parade, Lugarno as recognised by the National Trust listing for its significant Early Settler History and Aboriginal Cultural Heritage and the cultural, environmental and educational benefits of preserving the property for future generations;
- (b) Notes that the NSW Government Interim Heritage Order currently in place for 'Glenlee', 80 Boronia Parade, Lugarno will lapse on 14 February 2022;
- (c) Fully supports protecting 'Glenlee', 80 Boronia Parade, Lugarno by the future gazettal of a new Interim Heritage Order to be in place on the site for 12 months and thanks Mr James Griffin MP, Minister for Environment and Heritage for responding to the community campaign to save 'Glenlee', 80 Boronia Parade, Lugarno from development, and acknowledges the advocacy of Mr Mark Coure MP, Member for Oatley in this regard;
- (d) Provides all assistance necessary for the Minister to achieve listing 'Glenlee', 80 Boronia Parade, Lugarno on the State Heritage Register;
- (e) Thanks Council officers for consistently pursuing the protection of the 'Glenlee' site, 80 Boronia Parade, Lugarno in accordance with Council's earlier resolutions to protect the site; and
- (f) Authorises the General Manager to immediately prepare a Planning Proposal to include the item 'Glenlee', 80 Boronia Parade, Lugarno on Schedule 5 of the Georges River Local Environmental Plan 2021.
