Planning proposal (PP-2022-59) to amend Mid-Western Regional Local Environmental Plan 2012 to facilitate further development of Glen Willow Regional Sports Complex at Part Lot 1 and Lot 2 DP 1252505, 58 Pitts Lane, Putta Bucca

I am writing in response to the planning proposal you have forwarded to the Minister under section 3.34(1) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) to rezone land from RU4 Primary Production Small Lots to RE1 Public Recreation and to remove the minimum lot size of 20ha at Part Lot 1 and Lot 2 DP 1252505, 58 Pitts Lane, Putta Bucca.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning, I have determined that the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the enclosed Gateway determination.

I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, the inconsistency of the planning proposal with applicable directions of the Minister under section 9.1 of the Act Direction 9.2 Rural Lands is justified in accordance with the terms of the Direction and no further work is required.

I have determined not to authorise Council to be the local plan-making authority as Council, being the land owner, has an interest in the land and proposed development.

Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible. Council's request for the Department of Planning and Environment to draft and finalise the LEP should be made eight (8) weeks in advance of the date the LEP is projected to be made.

The NSW Government has committed to reduce the time taken to complete LEPs. To meet these commitments, the Minister may appoint an alternate planning proposal authority if Council does not meet the timeframes outlined in the gateway determination.

The Department's categorisation of planning proposals in the *Local Environmental Plan Making Guideline* (Department of Planning and Environment, 2021) is supported by category specific timeframes for satisfaction of conditions and authority and Government agency referrals, consultation, and responses. Compliance with milestones will be monitored by the Department to ensure planning proposals are progressing as required.
