Gateway Determination

Planning proposal (Department Ref: PP-2023-141): Amend Bega Valley LEP 2013 to rezone part Lot 882 DP 789858 Red Gum Road, Yellow Pinch to SP2 Infrastructure Zone

I, Daniel Thompson the Director, Southern Region at the Department of Planning and Environment, as delegate of the Minister for Planning and Public Places, have determined under section 3.34(2) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) that an amendment to the Bega Valley Local Environmental Plan 2013 to rezone part Lot 882 DP 789858 Red Gum Road, Yellow Pinch to SP2 Infrastructure Zone should proceed subject to the following conditions:

The Council as planning proposal authority is authorised to exercise the functions of the local plan-making authority under section 3.36(2) of the Act subject to the following:

- (a) the planning proposal authority has satisfied all the conditions of the gateway determination.
- (b) the planning proposal is consistent with applicable directions of the Minister under section 9.1 of the Act, or the Secretary has agreed that any inconsistencies are justified; and
- (c) there are no outstanding written objections from public authorities.

The LEP should be completed on or before 1st May 2024.

Gateway Conditions

- 1. The planning proposal is to be amended to include a traffic study as required by Transport for NSW prior to agency and community consultation.
- 2. Public exhibition is required under section 3.34(2)(c) and clause 4 of Schedule 1 to the Act as follows:
 - (a) the planning proposal is categorised as standard as described in the Local Environmental Plan Making Guidelines (Department of Planning and Environment, 2021) and must be made publicly available for a minimum of 20 working days; and
 - (b) the planning proposal authority must comply with the notice requirements for public exhibition of planning proposals and the specifications for material that must be made publicly available along with planning proposals as identified in *Local Environmental Plan Making Guidelines* (Department of Planning and Environment, 2021).
- 3. Consultation is required with the following public authorities and government agencies under section 3.34(2)(d) of the Act and/or to comply with the requirements of applicable directions of the Minister under section 9 of the EP&A Act:
 - Biodiversity and Conservation
 - Local Aboriginal Land Council

- NSW Heritage
- NSW Rural Fire Service
- Transport for NSW

Each public authority is to be provided with a copy of the planning proposal and any relevant supporting material via the NSW Planning Portal and given at least 30 days to comment on the proposal.

4. A public hearing is not required to be held into the matter by any person or body under section 3.34(2)(e) of the EP&A Act. This does not discharge Council from any obligation it may otherwise have to conduct a public hearing (for example, in response to a submission or if reclassifying land).
