### **Recommendation:**

- A. Council note the recommendations contained in the report prepared by *Lucas Stapleton Johnson & Partners* dated 15 June 2023, which concludes that no properties in the eastern side of Bay Street, Double Bay (between New South Head Road and Short Street) warrant listing as a heritage conservation area under Schedule 5 of the Woollahra Local Environmental Plan 2014.
