Request for Gateway Determination - Enmore Road Special Entertainment Precinct

On 14 March 2023, Inner West Council considered a planning proposal to amend the Inner West Local Environmental Plan 2022 (IWLEP) to continue operation of the Enmore Road Special Entertainment Precinct (SEP) in perpetuity. Council resolved (C0323(1) Item 5) to forward it to the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) for a gateway determination.

Please find enclosed a copy of the planning proposal prepared in accordance with Section 3.33 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) and DPE's '*Local Environmental Plan Making Guideline*'.

The Planning Proposal seeks to amend Clause 6.32 of IWLEP 2022 by removing the 31 July 2023 end date, allowing the Enmore Road SEP to continue in perpetuity. The proposal is accompanied by the following documents to assist DPE in understanding the effect of the proposal:
