NOTICE OF PUBLIC EXHIBITION OF A PLANNING PROPOSAL

TO AMEND WINGECARRIBEE LOCAL ENVIRONMENTAL PLAN 2010

On 15 March 2023 Council resolved to proceed with a Planning Proposal amend WLEP 2010 to remove the requirement for a Development Application for certain events on public land that is bushfire prone. It is noted that while the Planning Proposal would remove the need for a Development Application, the assessment of the suitability of a public event on bushfire prone land would still occur through Council's lease / licencing processes for the use of public land. On 22 July 2023, the NSW Department of Planning Housing & Environment issued a Gateway Determination to progress the Planning Proposal to public exhibition and the Planning Proposal is now exhibited in accordance with the Gateway requirements and submissions sought from the community.

EXHIBITION DATES: The Planning Proposal is on public exhibition for a period of 30 days from Monday 2 September to Friday 11 October.

Only written submissions can be considered and must be received by Council before 4.30pm on Friday 11 October 2024 and quote file reference **PP-2024-1360**. Although submissions may be viewed by a third party, they would be redacted beforehand (i.e. all identifying features removed).

It is noted that Wingecarribee Shire Council is authorised to exercise the functions of the Minister for Planning under s.3.36 of the Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979 as have been delegated to it with regard to this Planning Proposal.
