Planning proposal PP-2024-829 to amend Kempsey Local Environmental Plan 2013

I am writing in response to the planning proposal you have forwarded to the Minister under section 3.34(1) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act) in respect of the planning proposal to rezone Lot 9 DP 1219664, 157 Arakoon Road, South West Rocks from R5 Large Lot Residential to R1 General Residential and amend the associated development controls.

As delegate of the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, I have determined that the planning proposal should proceed subject to the conditions in the enclosed gateway determination.

I have also agreed, as delegate of the Secretary, the inconsistency of the planning proposal with applicable directions of the Minister under section 9.1 of the Act 4.5 Acid Sulfate Soils and 5.1 Integrating Land Use and Transport is justified in accordance with the terms of the Direction.

Council may still need to obtain the agreement of the Secretary to comply with the requirements of relevant applicable directions of the Minister under section 9.1 of the Act 1.1 Implementation of Regional Plans, 3.1 Conservation Zones, 4.3 Planning for Bushfire Protection and 4.4 Remediation of Contaminated Land. Council should ensure this occurs prior to the LEP being made.

Considering the nature of the planning proposal I have determined that Council may exercise local plan-making authority functions in relation to the planning proposal.

The amending local environmental plan (LEP) is to be finalised within nine months of the date of the Gateway determination. Council should aim to commence the exhibition of the planning proposal as soon as possible.
