 - 3. A plan showing the location of all storage containers, the nature and limitations of their contents to be submitted prior to any work commencing.
 - If not required by other conditions of consent a Pre-incident plan is to be developed in consultation with the NSWFB and RFS. A copy of this plan is to be submitted to Council. Council is to ensure that copies are distributed to NSWFB & RFS and Community Liaison Committee.
