6. Business Item Recommendations

2010SYE020 Randwick DA No. 215/2010 – 4/5 storey apartment buildings consisting of 132 apartments, 265-271 Avoca Street, Randwick

- 1. David Furlong declared an interest of which he became aware during the first part of the meeting. He withdrew from the Panel.
- 2. The remaining Panel, by a majority of 3 to 1 (John Roseth, Mary-Lynne Taylor and Murray Matson against Scott Nash) resolved to reject the recommendation of the planning assessment report and to refuse the application on the grounds that the variation in development standards (in particular in the FSR) is to great and unjustified by the surroundings of the site and the circumstances of the case.
- 3. The Panel is aware of the exisitng consent for a development at a FSR of 1:4:1 and would therefore reluctantly accept a variation to this level, but not further.
- 4. Scott Nash accepts the recommendation of the planning report and would therefore approve the development.
- 5. In view of the Voluntary Planning Agreement between the Council and the applicant any SEPP 1 objections in a future application should be assessed by an independent planner rather than one employed by the Council.
