- 2) The Panel notes that the applicant has submitted amended drawings this afternoon. The council has not accepted those drawings on the grounds that the late lodgement does not allow adequate time to assess the amended proposal.

 - a) the applicant has already once submitted amended drawings, so that the proposal submitted this afternoon is the third version of the application;
 - b) the application was lodged in April 2010; a deferral and reassessment would postpone the decision at least until February 2011, thus extending the determination period to nine months, while the Panel aims to deal with applications within three months;
 - c) A refusal will allow the applicant to lodge a new application as well as the notification of the new proposal to concerned residents.
