Greg Woodham	spoke on behalf of the elected council. The council requests the Panel to impose two additional conditions (see Panel's resolution)
Noni de Carvalho	who was the author of the assessment report, responded to the objectors, saying that the scale was appropriate for the Chatswood town centre

## 4. Business Item Recommendations

## 2010SYE032 Willoughby DA No. 2010/367 – 38 Albert Avenue, Chatswood .

1. The Panel resolved unanimously to accept the planning assessment report's recommendation to approve the application, for the reasons mentioned in the report, and subject to the conditions recommended in the report, except as follows.

- 2. The use of the space proposed for a liquor outlet is not approved for the reasons that the application provides no details, such as hours of operation and fit-out. A separate development application for the use of that space is required.
- 3. Deferred condition 4 of Schedule 1 is deleted on the ground that it is not specific.
- 4. In response to the submission by the elected council, two additional conditions are included, i.e.

4(f) The shared path between Claude Street and Albert Avenue is to be increased in width, where possible, to 3.5 metres.
4(g) The applicant is to fund the provision of a public art "identifier" above the Albert Avenue end of the shared path the signal the location of the pathway adjacent to the pedestrian crossing lights. Details of the public art are to be determined in consultation with council's Public Art Officer.

5. In response to concern by objectors about noise from the loading dock, an additional condition is included:

Condition 132. There shall be no vehicle services to and from the loading dock (except for waste collection) between 9pm and 7am.
