- (d) That the fees and charges for Display of Merchandise be \$189/week for full display, \$218/fortnight for half display (up to 3m<sup>2</sup>), \$331 per month for single table only (up to 1.25m<sup>2</sup>) and these charges be incorporated into the Fees and Charges Schedule of the City of Ryde Management Plan.
