1. The Panel resolves unanimously to accept the recommendation of the planning assessment report to grant deferred commencement consent to the application, for the reasons mentioned in the report and subject to the conditions recommended in the report.

- 2. The Panel is aware that many of the objectors consider the scale of the proposed building inappropriate. However, the proposal complies with the FSR and almost complies with the maximum height control applying to the site. Although the proposal is now much larger than the buildings around it, these controls are likely to increase the scale of development in the vicinity.
- 3. In reaching its decision, the Panel was conscious that there are numerous constraints on this site, the major one of which is to minimise overshadowing the houses to the east. The proposal concentrates its bulk towards Rocky Point Road and maximises its separation from the east. The Panel placed major weight on maintaining the amenity of residents to the east.
