a) The Subdivision Certificate for the preceding stage/ subdivision pursuant to Development Consent DA 1357/2010/ZB has been registered with the NSW Land and Property Management Authority unless the two are issued and registered concurrently; or b) Access to the development site has been provided via construction and dedication of the necessary section of road and the roundabout at the intersection of Withers Road/Mungerie Road/Proposed Road 5 extension under Development Consent DA 1357/2010/ZB. Further, alternative emergency egress arrangements are to be provided to the satisfaction of the RFS.

Condition 11, to be deleted and the wording to be used as an advisory note in the appropriate section.
