JRPP PUBLIC BRIEFING MEETING - 2 May 2011

The Joint Regional Planning Panel was introduced in NSW on 1 July 2009 in order to strengthen decision making on regionally significant development applications (DAs) and certain other planning matters.

On 2 May 2011, the Northern Region Joint Regional Planning Panel held a meeting at the Kyogle Memorial Hall in Kyogle NSW.

The major issues raised from the broader community at the Public Briefing are as follows:

- 1. Health Issues occuring from excess dust from the blastings
- 2. Overuse and inadequate conditions of the main Bridge
- 3. Expense to rate payers of rebuilding a new bridge
- 4. Status of Aboriginal archeological studies
- 5. Devaluation of property prices around the proposed quarry site/compensation to landowners
- 6. Industry required
- 7. Operating hours of the Quarry
- 8. Restoration of Smiths Creek Road

The Panel has yet to confirm a date in which this matter will be determined.
