



## **JRPP PUBLIC BRIEFING MEETING – 2 May 2011**

### **Final Briefing meeting Notes**

The Joint Regional Planning Panel was introduced in NSW on 1 July 2009 in order to strengthen decision making on regionally significant development applications (DAs) and certain other planning matters.

On 2 May 2011, the Northern Region Joint Regional Planning Panel held a public briefing meeting at the Kyogle Memorial Hall in Kyogle NSW to understand community concerns on the proposed establishment and operation of a quarry at Edenville Road, Cedar Point.

The following is a brief summary of the key issues raised from the broader community at the meeting:

1. Health Issues occurring from excess dust from the blastings
2. Overuse and inadequate conditions of the main Bridge
3. Expense to rate payers of rebuilding a new bridge
4. Status of Aboriginal archeological studies
5. Devaluation of property prices around the proposed quarry site/compensation to landowners
6. Industry required (potential impact on local industries)
7. Operating hours of the Quarry
8. Noise
9. Ecology
10. Stormwater and other water related issues including groundwater, water quality
11. Visual impacts
12. Increased road traffic by trucks impacting on school buses and private vehicles
13. Residential amenity

Mr West, the Chair of the Northern Joint Regional Planning Panel has confirmed that the original Point 8 (Resoration of Smiths Creek Road) was not a key issue raised at the briefing meeting.

When Council confirms a date when the assessment report will be completed, the Panel Secretariat will schedule a date for the Panel to consider the application. All interested parties who have made a submission to the Council or spoke to the Panel at the briefing meeting will be notified of the panel meeting.
