# 5. Business Item Recommendations

# ITEM 1 - 2011SYE058 Burwood D 65/2011 - Seniors Housing Development-(SEPP 5); No 8-10 Brighton Street, Croydon

- 1) The Panel resolves by a majority of 3 to 2 (for: John Roseth, Mary-Lynne Taylor and David Furlong; against Henson Liang and Sally Deans) that it will accept the recommendation of the planning assessment report to approve the application subject to the conditions recommended in the report (as amended in paragraph 2) when it is presented with a Site Audit Certificate applying to the whole of the site.
- 2)
- a) The fence to 25 Croydon Avenue should be 2m high, of acoustic material and built before construction begins. The wall to be approved by the council's Heritage Adviser.
- b) The kitchen windows on the ground floor of Building A should have obscure glass.
- c) In Planning Condition 8 the reference to standard roof should be to non-trafficable roof.
- 3) The majority of the Panel is mindful of the fact that there is a valid Masterplan for this site, that the proposal is smaller in scale than the Masterplan, and that its impact is less adverse than that of the Masterplan.
- 4) The majority of the Panel believes that to refuse this application, which it believes to be consistent with the approved Masterplan but which has less adverse impact, would be unreasonable.
- 5) Councillors Liang and Deans voted to defer the application in order to achieve a proposal with lower height, specifically two-storeys to Brighton Street.
