5. Business Item Recommendations

ITEM 1 - 2011SYE069 – Lane Cove - DA11/100 - Demolition of existing buildings and the erection of 4 residential flat buildings containing 141 dwellings - 1-8 Nield Avenue, Greenwich

1. The Panel resolves unanimously to accept the recommendation of the planning assessment report to approve the application, for the reasons mentioned in the report and subject to the conditions recommended in the report, with the deletion of the words "*This could be provided by a lift near the Nield Avenue pedestrian entrance to the podium level and by ensuring a continuous accessible path of travel from the lift landing to the entrance of all residential blocks*" in Condition 40 and with the addition of the words *"with no construction traffic from Bellevue Avenue"* at the end of Condition 66.

2. The Panel has considered the written and oral concerns of objectors, which related mainly to the retention of trees and to construction traffic. The Panel is satisfied that the applicant has responded to concerns about the accuracy of tree surveys and that the chances of success for the trees nominated to be retained is about the same as for most development proposals. The Panel is also satisfied that the Construction Management Plan will resolve concerns of construction traffic.
