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5. Business Item Recommendations

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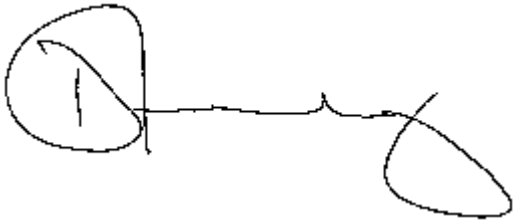
1. The Panel resolves unanimously to approve the application as recommended in the supplementary report prepared by Council's assessment staff, subject to the conditions contained in that report and the original assessment report.

2. In arriving at the decision outlined in point 1, a majority of the Panel (Sue Francis, Con Hindi and Philip Sansom) is concerned that the amended plans have not achieved the height and FSR requirements of points 2 and 3 of the Panel's previous resolution. Accordingly, the majority of the Panel requires the imposition of a further condition to remove an additional floor from the Barratt Street section of the building, so as to match the height of the adjoining building.

3. David Furlong was happy to approve the amended proposal, without further reduction in height.
