The Panel, having carefully considered the report and submissions, including representations made at the meeting favour granting consent to the development application subject to the above matters being able to be satisfactorily addressed and subject to some amendments to recommended conditions of consent as outlined at the meeting and with possible further conditions added to address any matters raised in the supplementary report.

Upon receiving the supplementary report, the Panel may determine the application electronically. The decision of the panel will be published on JRPP website and Council Officers are to notify the objectors.
