 The Panel resolves by a majority of 4 to 1 (for: John Roseth, David Furlong, Sue Francis and Tom Robertson; against: Michel Reymond) that it is satisfied with the recommendation of the planning assessment report to approve the application, for the reasons given in the report and subject to the conditions recommended in the report, except that:

- a) The condition requiring the reduction of the height of the external glass tower by two floors is deleted;
- b) The conditions should be refined to avoid unnecessary and duplicated conditions.
- 2) The Panel requests the planning assessment officer to prepare, by 22 November 2012, a revised set of conditions as indicated above. Following circulation of the revised set of conditions the Panel will determine the application by communicating by electronic means.
- 3) The reason for the Panel not requiring a reduction of two storeys in the height of the glass tower, recommended in the planning assessment report, is that such a requirement would destroy the purpose of the application and would thus be tantamount to refusal.
- 4) Councillor Reymond voted to remove the bay nearest to Don Bank for heritage reasons.
