1. The majority of the Panel notes that the revised proposal meets the requirements set by the Panel at its meeting on13 December 2012. The majority (for: John Roseth, David Furlong, Tim Moore and Ernest Wong; against: John Faker) accepts the recommendation of the planning assessment report to approve the application, for the reasons mentioned in the

- report and subject to the conditions recommended in the report, except Waste Management Condition 6, which is deleted as it is not necessary.
- 2. The Panel notes that there will be an impact on existing views from 35 Belmore Street. However, given the permissible height and FSR controls relating to the subject site, the preservation of those views would require an unreasonable reduction of the development potential of the subject site.
- 3. Councillor Faker voted against approval because, in his opinion, the three towers should not be the same height.
