- Council officers are to provide the applicant with a copy of the latest flooding map and confirm that this is the best available current information and provide any necessary qualifications about its use or interpretation. This is to happen today;
- Invite the applicant to modify the current application: it appears to the panel that some parts
  of site may be unconstrained and a modified and possibly staged application may be
  appropriate;
- The Panel believes that any revised application should be accompanied by a statement from Worley Parsons in relation to flooding impacts; and
- The panel would be willing to consider a revised application expediously and hopes that such can be reported to a meeting in October 2012.
