4. Visitor parking

Visitor parking is to be low key with planting interspersed between parking bays and flush edges to hard surfaces. This planting is to consist of a low woodland understorey with sporadic trees at the base of the retaining wall.

5. Rear pedestrian access and building entry

Along the rear of the buildings an accessible path links all building entries with the communal spaces and the broader pedestrian circuits. This path will wind along the existing sandstone cutting and through beds of native planting along the building frontage.
