

PLANTING STRATEGIES

The planting proposals intend to use a variety of native plant species.

New planting will consist of an ornamental native understorey with varying forms, textures and shades of colour beneath carefully located feature trees.

A swathe of clear stem native trees moves through the communal areas, providing interest, shade and a visual link to the adjacent bushland. Small, feature trees will also be grouped at entry points to soften building lines and the flight of stairs as well as stagger canopy foliage up the terraces.
