5. Business Item Recommendations

ITEM 1 - 2013SYE025 – Randwick - DA/702/2012 - Removal of existing "Block D" demountable classrooms and construction of part 4/5 level building with classrooms, multi purpose and performance space - 20 Stanley Street, Randwick

- The Panel resolves unanimously to accept the recommendation of the planning assessment report to approve the application, for the reasons mentioned in the report and subject to the conditions recommended in the report, except that Condition 26 is changed to require the applicant to pay for a super-advanced replacement tree.
- 2. The Panel considered the elected council's submission regarding the retention of the Willow Myrtle in Chepstow Street. However, the Panel notes that the planning assessment report

considers that the tree will not be safe following the 30% encroachment into its Tree Protection Zone.

3. The Panel notes Mr Clayton's suggestion that a temporary screen wall be built on the Chepstow Street boundary and requests the council and the applicant to deal with this request at the time of approving the final Construction Management Plan. At that time the council should also consider the best location for construction sheds, so as to preserve the maximum number of adult street trees.
