6-26 GROVE STREET AND 60-64 CONSTITUTION ROAD, DULWICH HILL

Development application (DA201300375) to consolidate 16 lots, demolish all existing improvements and remediation of land, followed by comprehensive redevelopment of the site to contain 249 dwellings and one ground floor retail premise, within 4 buildings of heights varying from 3 to 8 storeys over 2 levels of basement for 270 vehicles combined with ancillary development works to include civil works, internal road construction, tree removal and landscaping.

On 8 April, 2014, Council considered the officer's assessment report on the abovementioned development application, that has already been sent to you.

At that meeting, the elected Council resolved to support the officer's assessment report but raised concerns about:

- the exceedence of the FSR control;
- the level of overshadowing; 2
- 3 traffic impacts;
- 4 the impact of construction hours; and
- 5 the loss of solar access.

At the same meeting the elected Council agreed that should the Panel grant consent to the development application, they will enter into to a VPA with the proponent. A copy of the officer's report on the VPA is also attached.

I would be pleased if you could ensure that the Panel is advised of the elected Council's resolutions, and a copy of the enclosed documents is provided to the Panel for their consideration in accordance with Clause 4.6 of the Procedures for the Operation of Joint Regional Planning Panel.
