5. **Business Item Recommendations**

ITEM 1 - 2013SYE064 - Marrickville - DA201300375 - Arlington Grove - 6-26 Grove Street & 60 Constitution Road, Dulwich Hill

- 1. The Panel resolves unanimously to accept the recommendation of the Supplementary Planning Assessment report and approve the DA for the reasons contained in the report and subject to the conditions contained in the report.
- 2. The Panel requests that the Council staff make a final review of the conditions to ensure that reports are nominated as Reference documents only and that the conditions requiring final amendments to the plans are brought forward to make them more obvious.

- 3. In arriving at its decision the Panel formed the view that:
 - a) The variation in FSR as proposed under Clause 4.6 of the LEP is reasonable in relation to the general compliance of the proposal with the relevant planning framework;
 - b) The proposal generally meets the relevant DCP controls for the site and the resultant desired future character envisaged by the DCP;
 - c) While the sunlight penetration levels suggested by the applicant may be a little high in reality, the outcome is reasonable in the context of the site's orientation. In this regard it is noted that the proposal is seeking to vary the DCP building layout to achieve a higher number of north facing units.
