RESOLVED unanimously on the motion of CIr Campbell, seconded CIr Simms that Council prepare a submission to the JRPP separate to this report on the grounds that the development:-

- 1. Is much higher than the other buildings in the area and completely out of character.
- 2. Is higher than current residents were led to believe was permissible by the then planning controls.
- 3. Lacks infrastructure, particularly roads and public transport.
- 4. Will lead to an inevitable increase in the already unacceptable traffic congestion.
- 5. Will increase pressure on parking.
- 6. Lacks strategic justification for additional residential development in this location.
- 7. Is absence of any review of a parking management plan in Wentworth Point.
- 8. Lacked adequate community consultation.
- 9. Has such high density that it is unsustainable and jeopardises the lifestyle and amenity of Wentworth Point residents.
- 10. Height and density are not in the public interest.
