Reasons for the panel decision:			
The facility is in the public interest in that it will generate further power supplies particularly in peak periods			
when most needed; it will be able to operate without adverse environmental impacts particularly in relation to			
exhaust emissions; the operation is conducted in a manner that will render it safe in relation to fire; there will			
be no impact from or by its proximity to the railway line; the site is located in industrial area which will render			
impact on nearby residences insignificant and is adjacent to appropriate electrical distribution infrastructure.			
Thereby, the panel considers that the development will not impact on natural or built environments and is a			
suitable use of the industrial lands.			
Conditions: The development application was approved subject to the conditions in Appendix A of the			
Council Assessment Report as amended at the meeting. These amendments are as follows:			
Delete the note at the bottom of Condition 15 "Note: This condition is only applicable where the total			
development value exceeds \$100,000.			
 Add "Used oils shall be removed from the facility by a suitably qualified contractor immediately upon 			
completion of servicing" to Condition 7.			
 Change the first part of Condition 11 from "Prior to works commencing for the installation of 			
equipment associated with the development, the applicant shall submit a report for council's			
reference" to "Prior to works commencing for the installation of equipment associated with the			
development, the applicant shall submit a report for the approval of Council's Manager of			
Development Services"
