Determination and Statement of Reasons

Item 1: 2014HCC020 – DA/1250/2014, Lake Macquarie City Council, Health Service Facility – Additions to Existing Hospital, 3 Sydney and 12 O'Brien Streets, Gateshead

Item 2: 2014HCC002 – DA/1940/2013, Waste Management/Recycling Facility being a Composting Facility, 367 and 413 Wilton Road, Awaba

Date of determination: 9 October 2014

Decision:

The panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule A pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

Motion Item 1: Recommend approval of DA/1250/2014 with the addition of condition 29 to require landscaping along the Pacific Highway frontage and deletion of advice regarding Section 82A. Carried unanimously.

Motion Item 2: Recommend approval of DA/1940/2013 as amended by recommendation of Council staff at the JRPP meeting in relation to conditions 13, 16, 19, 34 and 40 with further changes to:

- Condition 2 to reference the EIS and all supporting documentation;
- Condition 9 to correct 'mein' to 'mine';
- Condition 33 to correct the car parking allocation in accordance with the assessment report;
- Condition 40 to include the words "facility should not receive collect or treat sewage sludges or grease trap waste" at the end of the condition.
- General Terms of Approval be clarified to state that the GTAs have been included in the conditions.





The panel considered: the matters listed at Item 6, the material listed at Item 7 and the material presented at the meeting and the matters observed at the site inspections for the items.
