

Submission to JRPP following consideration of Development proposal by RVC.

Councillors raised concerns that after the Pacific Hwy upgrade works were completed (5yrs) any northbound haulage of quarry product (25 year life) would have to be hauled through the Woodburn streets because no northbound highway on-ramp is available. They resolved to raise this concern with the JRPP as these future truck movements could adversely impact on the amenity of the Woodburn community.
