### Determination and Statement of Reasons

2014STH020 – Wagga Wagga – DA14/0448 [Cooramin Street, Cartwright's Hill] as described in Schedule 1.

Date of determination: 09 April 2015

**Decision:** The panel determined to defer the development application for the reasons described below.

#### Panel consideration:

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

#### Reasons for the panel decision:

That the Southern Joint Regional Planning Panel defer D/A14/0448 Recreation Facility (Major) – Harness Racing Facility including earthworks, track, clubhouse, stables associated with this structure and requests that the applicant consider the layout of the facility to relocate the stables and truck parking and manoeuvring areas to the south-western corner to minimise traffic noise and visual impacts.

Further information is to be supplied by the applicant as follows:

- a. A comprehensive flood assessment of the impact of the proposed development on the flood regime of the locality addressing cumulative effects of flooding and the relevant requirements of the NSW Flood Plain Development Manual
- b. An assessment of the impacts of traffic and parking, including assumptions of patronage for all likely events with proposed mitigation measures
- c. An assessment of the impacts of noise from major activities, construction transport, and resulting impacts on surrounding residents
- d. Details of the extent and nature of additional fill to be imported to the site for the purposes of the construction of the facility
