1. INTRODUCTION

That following 12 months of the final occupation certificate being issued, the applicant is to engage a suitably qualified traffic consultant to undertake a traffic and pedestrian safety assessment of the development in relation to the Help St access and at the Help Street/ Anderson St intersection such report to document the assessment and provide recommendations to Council to address any issues identified.
