### Determination and Statement of Reasons

**Date of determination:** 17 December 2014

**Decision:**

The panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

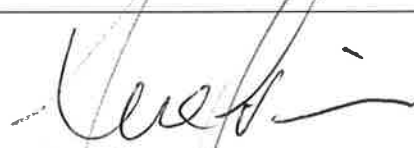
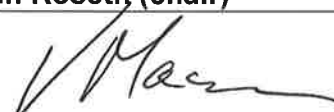
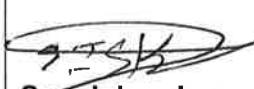
**Reasons for the panel decision:**

The application meets the needs and desires of the Newington Wyvern Preparatory School without imposing unreasonable impact on the surrounding area.

**Conditions:** As per revised version of the conditions of consent supplied by Council on 16 December 2014, with the following amendments made at the meeting:

1. In Condition 26 "3dBA" is changed to "5dBA" and the Note following the condition is deleted.
2. Conditions 13, 14 and 15 are deleted on the grounds that the site is far removed from the railway corridor.
3. Conditions 23, 24, 63 and 84 are amended according to the agreement between the council and the applicant.
4. A new condition is to be imposed requiring the installation of CCTV to the car park entry and the entrance to the early learning centre.
