

## Landscape Concept Design Statement

The streetscape design theme continues existing positive streetscape elements. The existing materials palette has been interpreted to provide a unified design.

Safe design principles have been adopted throughout by providing clear and logical pedestrian circulation routes, providing visible building entry points, visual cues for access, design for open surveillance (heights, minimal concealment), clear site lines at pedestrian crossing points and public lighting.

Equal access design principles have also been adopted.

Proposed trees provide summer shade and filtered screening of the proposed built form and low maintenance, drought tolerant plant species have been used throughout.







