### Determination and Statement of Reasons

2014SYW093 – Penrith, DA14/0932, Alterations and Additions to St Marys Rugby League Club to Expand the Club with Associated Car Parking and Landscaping Works, St Marys Rugby League Club, Boronia Road North, St Marys

**Date of determination:** 27 November 2014

**Decision:**

The panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* subject to the conditions given in Council planning report of the 27 November 2014

The panel considered: the matters raised within the planning report, the material submitted in support and the matters observed at site inspections for this item.






**Reasons for the panel decision:**

1. The proposal complies with the applicable development standards and guidelines and will improve quality of the building environment in the area.
2. The proposal will have no negative effects on the natural environment and the proposed landscaping will improve the visual amenity of the area.
3. The panel notes that the subject site is below the flood planning level but having considered the prescribed tests in clause 6.3 of the Penrith LEP 2010 believes that the proposal will not be adversely affected by, nor significantly affect flooding events.
4. The panel notes the possible minor shortfall in car parking in Stage 2 but believes this is appropriately addressed by Condition number 11.
5. The panel considers that the proposal's net social effect will be acceptable. Taking this into account and the proceeding four reasons the panel considers the proposal will be in the public interest.

**Conditions:** The development application was approved subject to the minor modifications to conditions in the Council Assessment Report with amendments to Condition numbers:

- 1 - modification of plan numbers.
- 11 – to delete the word 'amended'
