#### **Determination and Statement of Reasons**

**2015HCC001 – DA1179/2014 –** Wyong Shire Council, Concept Plan for retail premises comprising 2 stages with Stage 1 for Masters Homemaker Improvement Centre and associated site works, access and infrastructure, 60 Wyong Road, Tuggerah.

Date of determination: 19 November 2015

#### Panel consideration:

#### Panel Decision:

The Panel approves Development Application 1179/2014 for a staged development under Section 83B of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979. Approval is granted for the Concept Plan for a retail premises comprising 2 stages and Stage 1 being for a Masters Homemaker Improvement Centre, associated site works, access and infrastructure at 60 Wyong Road, Tuggerah, subject to amendments to the Draft Conditions of Consent as outlined below.

#### Conditions:

- 1 Amend Condition 1 to refer to the Landscape plans, Landscape public art Plan and the Concept Plan.
- The addition of new Condition 1A to reduce the height of the three large iconography signs and the "Best Price Guarantee" Sign on the south western elevation to 2798mm.
- 3 Amend Condition 6 as follows:.
  - Change the date from 10 March 2015 to 17 November 2015 to refer to the most recent correspondence from the NSW Office of Water.
  - Include JRPP amendments to condition 18 (iv) and (v) of the General Terms of Approval issued by NSW Office of Water to refer to Roads Authority Approval and the inclusion of the word "approximately" in reference to the 450m long riparian corridor to the West.
  - Deletion of the 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph of Condition 6.
  - 4 The deletion of conditions 7 and 8 referring to the Voluntary Planning Agreement between the Department of Planning and Environment and Scentre Limited and Orta Pty Ltd.
  - 5 The inclusion of "A" to refer to Section 94A of *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act* 1979.
  - 6 Amend condition 16 to include the following information referring to the Landscape Plans:
    - Drawing Nos 101, 102 and 501
    - Revision D
    - 15/12/2014
  - 7 Amend conditions 21, 36 and 72 to delete the reference to "RTA" and replace with the correct Authority being "RMS"
