Public meeting held at Shoalhaven City Council on 28 November 2018, opened at 4.00pm and closed at 4.36pm.

MATTER DETERMINED

2015STH014 – Shoalhaven – RA15/1000 at Cnr Berry and Worrigee Streets, Nowra (as described in Schedule 1)

PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered: the matters listed at item 6, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and briefings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel determined to approve the development application pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, subject to the conditions in the report amended as follows.

i) Addition of a New Condition

An amended landscape plan is to be submitted that provides for the additional advanced 100 litre
container size planting in the south eastern corner of the site along the boundaries. The planting is
to comprise a continuation of the existing planting along the southern boundary.

ii) Amendment to Condition 29 to read

Details of the final design treatment for the southern wall of the structure (for approval by Council)

A design treatment must be either a continuation of the folded perforated panel proposed for the other street facades or other design treatment compatible with the other facades and may include a mural.

The design treatment must be endorsed by Council in consultation with the Owners Corporation of the Berry Court (proprietors of SP 3682).

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report amended as outlined above.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- The application was amended to comply with the Shoalhaven Local Environmental Plan 2014 height control and reflect Council's policy (Development Control Plan) controls.
- Improved architectural design.

• The applicant has recognised the streetscape contribution of the trees by retaining the majority and provided appropriate setbacks.
