### Panel Decision:

- 1. The Panel voted unanimously to defer the determination of the application. The reason for this is that the Panel became aware that the notification for this application did not include the information that the Panel, rather than the council, was the consent authority. In addition, it appears that properties on the other side of New Canterbury Road (who are in Marrickville) were not notified.
- 2. The Panel requests the council to rectify the above by re-notifying the application and ensuring that owners in Marrickville are included. The Panel also requests the council to prepare a supplementary report at the end of the re-exhibition period, and no later than by the end of July 2015.
- 3. Finally, the Panel requests the council to re-visit the issue of the cl 4.6 variation of the height standard in its supplementary report in order to ensure that any variation is justified.

This should be done in the light of recent Land and Environment Court judgments dealing with the subject.

4. Following receipt of the supplementary report the Panel will set another date for a public meeting in order to determine the application.
