Determination and Statement of Reasons

2015SYE084 – Northern Beaches - N0240/15 - Holmeport Marina - replacement of swing moorings with fixed berths and increase in total berths from 59 to 73 - 2A McCarrs Creek Road, Church Point as described in Schedule 1.

Date of determination: 18 July 2016

Decision:

The panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

Panel consideration:

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6 as addressed in the Council Assessment Report, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1. The panel adjourned during the meeting to deliberate on the matter and formulate a resolution,

Reasons for the panel decision:

1. The proposal meets the objectives of the W2 Recreational Waterway zoning.
2. The application will increase the number of fixed moorings and decrease the number of swing moorings while resulting in a decrease of total moorings.
3. The redevelopment of the marina will not increase its environmental impact. The impact of fixed moorings is less than that of swing moorings.
4. The Panel has considered the objectors' concern that the surrendered swing moorings may be re-allocated. The Panel believes, however, that it can consider this application only in its own context, namely that it involves the surrender of thirty swing moorings. Any future proposal by the Roads and Maritime Services in relation to additional swing moorings in McCarrs Creek will need to be considered in terms of its own impact.
5. The Panel has also considered the objectors' concern about the proposal's impact on the availability of parking. All the expert advice, both from the applicant and the council, before the Panel indicates that the impact of the proposal on parking is acceptable.

Conditions: The development application was approved subject to the conditions recommended in the assessment report, except:

Deferred Commencement Condition A1 becomes an operational condition C1, with the other conditions in Part C appropriately re-numbered.

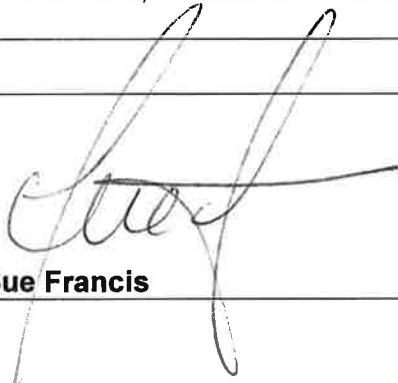
Condition B19 is amended in accordance with the Minutes of the Northern Beaches Council's Internal Review Unit's meeting of 30 June 2016.

Condition D18 is deleted and re-instated as Condition E6 with amended wording as per the minutes above.

Condition D19 is amended to require not the removal but the re-positioning of the boom gates.

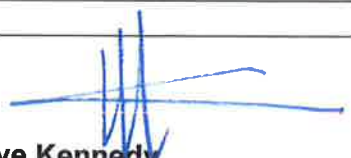
Wherever there is a reference to Pittwater Council, it becomes a reference to Northern Beaches Council.
