### Determination and Statement of Reasons

2015SYE134 – Sutherland – DA15/1148 - Alterations & Additions to Lark Ellen Aged Care Facility - 133, 135, 137 & 139 Jannali Avenue, Sutherland as described in Schedule 1.

**Date of determination:** 15 June 2016

**Decision:**

The panel determined to refuse the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

**Panel consideration:**

The panel considered: the matters listed at item 6 as addressed in the Council Assessment Report, the material listed at item 7 and the material presented at meetings and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1. The panel adjourned during the meeting to deliberate on the matter and formulate a resolution.

**Reasons for the panel decision:**

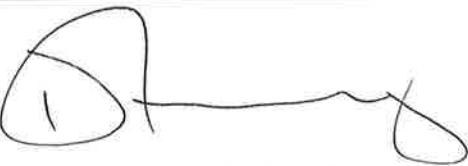

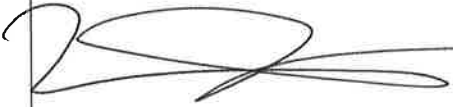


The panel adopted the assessment of those matters in the Council Assessment Report.

The principal reason for the panel decision was the failure of the proposal to meet a number of the requirements of the SEPP (Housing for Seniors or People with a Disability) 2004 and the Sutherland LEP, 2015 and that no requests to vary those standards under Clause 4.6 of the LEP have been submitted.

However, the panel noted the advice of Council's planning staff that a reduced proposal that sought to upgrade the existing seniors facility on the site may be capable of achieving development consent and urged the applicant to liaise with Council to achieve this outcome

**Conditions:** The development application was refused subject to the reasons set out in the recommendation contained in the Council's Planning Assessment report.
