Panel Decision:

The Panel is not satisfied that the issues raised in its decision of 16 March 2016 have been addressed. The Panel resolves therefore to again defer the determination of the application in order to request the applicant to submit, by 25 May 2016, a further amended application that achieves the following:

- a) The setback of the sixth level fronting Green Street is to line up with the neighbouring building to the east. The existing apartment layout may have to be changed.
- b) The amenity issues mentioned in the council's supplementary report in paragraph 2.3 are to be addressed, except for "kitchens located within main circulation spaces" and "window openings to common circulation spaces".
- c) The proliferation of service spaces (including plant rooms) on Basement 1 and level 00 is to be rationalised.
- d) The activation and appearance to Green Street is to be improved, including a larger retail presence.

Following receipt of the amended application, the Panel requests the council to provide it with a second supplementary report. The Panel will then determine the application by communicating by electronic means, unless a member of the Panel requests another meeting.
