## Determination and Statement of Reasons

**2015SYW047** – The Hills Shire Council – DA298/2011/JP/D – Section 96(2) Modification to an Approved place of worship, Delete Condition 10 of Development Consent No. 298/2011/JP which relates to the requirements of the NSW Roads and Maritime Services outlined in their letter dated 3 November 2010.

### Decision:

The panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 80 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

## Reasons for the panel decision:

- 1. The Panel agrees with the Council's assessment that this amending application is substantially the same and consistent with the original approval.

- 3. The application adequately satisfies the provisions of SEPP infrastructure and will have no greater impact on the surrounding built environment.
- 4. The traffic issues of concern to the two submittors have been addressed satisfactorily by the approved Parking Management Plan.
- 5. The Panel agrees to delete Condition 10 and to substitute the following condition:

Access to the site via North Rocks Road during Sunday services and major events is prohibited as documented in the approved Parking Management Plan prepared by Parking and Traffic Consultants dated 19 March 2015.
